

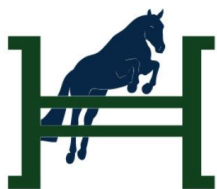

No cross entry of same horse and rider into classes more than .10 m higher than the special class. Example: Susan and Spot may compete in the 1.0m and still enter the Gambler's Choice at 0.95. However, if they enter a 1.10m class they are no longer eligible for the Gambler's Choice. A horse with a different rider may cross-enter, or the same rider on a different horse.

Wild Turkey Young Jumper Award for best 4, 5, & 6 yr old and overall.

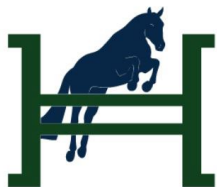

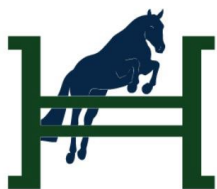

Covid-19 rules: Due to the changing situation, we cannot specify the covid-19 show rules at the time of publication of this prize list, but will post them on social media, and at the facility prior to the show so all are aware and prepared. Rules likely will involve social distance, good hygiene, masks, and 'show and go' rather than lingering on the grounds after your rounds. A rider, trainer, groom, parent, or any other person on the grounds may be asked to leave if they fail to comply with facility rules for covid-19.

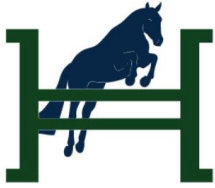
Show management and the judge reserve the right to excuse or eliminate from competition any horse or rider exhibiting dangerous behaviors, including, but not limited to, excessive speed, dangerously unbalanced turns, lack of safety in schooling arena or around other horses at the in-gate. A rider exhibiting unsportsman-like behavior toward their horse or other competitors may also be excused or eliminated from competition.

- All riders are required to wear boots and ASTM Certified Helmets at all times while mounted. This includes while mounted bareback.
- Schooling in the indoor arena is during the two times listed only and no jumping is allowed. Schooling in the outdoor arena will be open from 730am until completion of last class.
- No dogs allowed except ADA Service Animals. Therefore, any non-service dog on the grounds will have a \$50 donation to the non-profit Sound Equine Options added to their owner's show bill. Noted exception: There are dogs that belong to the facility owner/manager and are allowed on leash on the property during the show without penalty.
- Stalls and Day Runs will be available but limited; first come, first served with a non-refundable 50% deposit (Refunded in full if event is cancelled).
- Food and beverages may be available to purchase during the horse show dependent on covid-19 restrictions and vendor availability.

In classes with prize money, monies will be paid if there are at least four exhibitors in the class. Money to be distributed as follows: 30% first place, 20% second place, 15% third place, 10% fourth and fifth place, 5% sixth through eighth place.

Champions will be awarded to divisions with three or more classes at the show (0.75m, 0.85m, 0.95m, 0.75m Child/Adult, 0.85m Child/Adult, 0.95m Child/Adult, Trot-a-pole (green rider, green horse, open), Cross-Rails (green rider, green horse, open). Three or more competitors must have competed in order to receive the prize in addition to the ribbon. Ties will be broken

by the placing in the first class of the division. Points awarded as follows: First Place...10 points, Second Place...6 points, Third Place...4 points, Fourth Place...2 points, Fifth Place...1 point, Sixth Place...1/2 point. **Thank you to Champion prize sponsor Horseplay!**

High-Point and Reserve High-Point will be awarded to divisions with two classes at the show (0.5m, 0.65m, 1.0m, 1.10m, 1.15m, 1.2m). Three or more competitors must have competed in order to receive the prize in addition to the ribbon. Points awarded as follows: First Place...10 points, Second Place...6 points, Third Place...4 points, Fourth Place...2 points, Fifth Place...1 point, Sixth Place...1/2 point; in the event of a tie, the first class of the division will be the tie-breaker. **Thank you to High Point prize sponsor Purvida Healthy Horse and Reserve High Point sponsor Double J Trailers!**

Directions: From I-5 in Clark County, Washington, take Exit 9 (Fairgrounds exit). Head east for 4 miles. Turn right (south) onto 92th Ave and go 0.4 miles. Turn right into the driveway marked by large entry gate with the Heirloom Equestrian Center logo. There is room for large trucks and trailers to enter the property.

Facilities: Indoor Arena used for competition: 120 x 200 with Equiloft footing. There is a heated club room as well as a viewing deck available for spectators. Riders have a covered area near the in-gate in which to await their round. Food and drink available for purchase. Outdoor arena used for warm-up: 120 x 200 with GGT footing. Wheel chair ramp to viewing deck, viewing room, and bathroom is on the front/south side of the arena. Jump cups are USEF compliant jumper cups with safety releases for back rails of oxers.

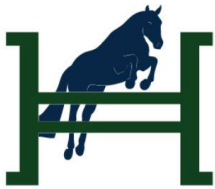

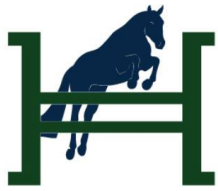
